FACILITY: Located at the Ohio University Natatorium

MEET: The meet will be held on July 15 and 16, 2006

EVENT SCHEDULE TIMES:

Facility doors open each day at 9:00AM because of Team practices.

Warm Ups begin at 9:30 AM each day with the meet beginning at 10:30 AM.

12 and under swimmers compete on July 15 – short course yards.

13 and over swimmers compete on July 16 – long course meters.

ENTRY FEE: \$3.00 per individual event. \$6.00 per relay event. Entry fees must be delivered to the league treasurer. Makes checks payable to “YMCA Southeast Swim League.”

CHECKS FOR T-SHIRTS AND ENTRIES GO TO SUSIE, AND ARE DUE BEFORE THE START OF THE MEET!

ENTRY LIMIT: 12 & under swimmers will be allowed to swim a maximum of three individual events plus one Medley and one Free relay. YMCA National age eligible swimmers (12 by start of Summer Nationals) may swim 4 individual events (The additional event(s) on Sunday). 13 & over swimmers will be allowed to swim a maximum of 4 individual events plus one Medley and one Free relay.

SEED TIMES: “NO TIMES” will not be accepted for any entries. Seed times should be submitted allowing conversion to the appropriate course.

PARTICIPANT QUALIFICATIONS: Recorded in the SEOWV League Rules and Regulations. Championships rules are covered in Article X. National YMCA eligibility rules also apply. Any entry of a swimmer indicates the team accepting accountability for meeting all of the participant qualifications.

As in all YMCA sports, any athlete who represented another team in open competition during the summer season is ineligible to compete for the YMCA that summer.

IMPLIED TEAM CERTIFICATION: Teams submitting entries certify that their entries meet all of the requirements to participate in YMCA swimming. This includes (but is not limited to) 90 days of YMCA membership, single team representation, minimum meet participation requirements and entry birth date.

RULES: The NCAA Swimming Handbook will govern the competition except where the SEOWV Swim League rules supersede.

ORDER OF EVENTS: Please see attached sheets. A Team Manager event list for the meet is posted on the league website.

SWIMMER AGE: The age-up date for Summer is June 1. Include swimmer birth dates in your Team file to allow the system to confirm ages.

EVENT LIST REMINDER: This is a NEW event list. Where we have open events, the swimmers will all compete based on seed times. Results for open events will be awarded to two age groups – 14 and under and also for 15 and over. While 12 year old swimmers are allowed to compete in open events, they will be competing with 13 and 14 year old swimmers. Since open events are now scoring events, the two-second limitation is now removed.

ENTRIES: All entries must be received by **July 7, 2006 by 6 PM**. Entries will only be accepted using HY-TEK and may be submitted by email, or received on disk by the due date. Mail entries (**no checks, please**) to:

REMINDER: Swimmers must have swum all events entered in the competition during the current YMCA season. Entry times may be challenged. **Be careful to enter a time appropriate for the pool the swimmer competed.** If you are entering a 25.50 time for a 25 meter time into a 25 yard event, enter 25.50S into Hy-Tek and allow the software to convert the time to the appropriate course.

SEEDING: All events will be pre-seeded according to entered times and swum as timed finals.

SPECIAL NEEDS: Should you have a swimmer who requires special assistance, please provide that information with your entries. The importance is to properly seed hearing-impaired swimmers near the starter.

SCORING: Individual events 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.
Relay Events: 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2.
Only two relays from one team may score in the same event.

AWARDS: Medals: First through third place, Individual and Relay. Ribbons: fourth through eighth place, Individual and Relay. A rotating trophy shall be presented to the first place team along with a gift certificate. (It is okay to use the certificate to buy a first place plaque.) Second and Third place teams will be presented with a plaque/trophies. Individual and team age group High Point trophies will be awarded.

AWARDS DELIVERY: Awards should be picked up by the coach or a designated representative at the end of the session or meet. Mailing of any awards will be at the expense of the team.

ADMISSION: No admission fee will be charged.

HEAT SHEETS: A \$3 fee will be charged for heat sheets on Sunday, while Saturday heat sheets will cost \$5.

NO FOOD OR DRINK ON DECK: A concession stand will be operating for visitors to the meet. There will be a hospitality room for the coaches and officials.

CLERK OF COURSE / BULLPEN: There will be a bullpen for the 12 and under session only (and no deck cards). A timer in each lane will verify the swimmers name from the heat sheet.

DECK ACCESS: Only coaches, officials, swimmers and meet workers will be permitted on the pool deck at any time.

COACHES CERTIFICATIONS: Coaches, a reminder that your certifications need to be current to be on deck. Check your certifications on the league website. Updates can be FAXed to Jon at (614) 751-1333. Certifications received after June 15 will require a \$25 late processing fee.

COACHES MEETING: Last minute instructions to coaches will be in the coaches packet. Please review this information and share with the other members of your team as quickly as possible.

TIMERS: Teams will be responsible for providing timers according to the need of the meet director and meet committee. The number of timers each team is responsible for will be based on the number of swimmers they have entered in each session. No team will have to supply more than four timer assignments per day. Team assignments will occur after the entries are compiled, and should be posted on the league website three days after entries are due.

For planning purposes, you may need a timer for each 15 swimmers entered each day. Each team may schedule their workers as they wish but must cover their assignments for each session. All timers starting at the meet each day should attend the timers meeting and provide their own watch. The Timers Meeting will be held 20 minutes prior to the start of each session in the hospitality room. **Each team must provide their timer with stopwatches.**

Please provide competent timers – this is a championship meet. Inexperienced timers may be requested to find a replacement.

TIME TRIALS: There will be time trials available at the conclusion of each day's session. Team entries will be due by the end of the breaststroke event. Relay entries will be due immediately upon the completion of the free relays. Time Trial entry fees will be added to the team statement on the league records for payment after the meet.

OFFICIALS: Each team should supply as many officials as possible. A minimum of one official per team is required. An official's Volunteer form is included in this packet.

MEET COMMITTEE: Per League By-laws and the NCAA rulebook, a Meet Committee will be designated and shall consist of the Meet Referee, a member of the League Rule Committee and others as assigned by the Meet Director. All decisions made by the committee shall be final.

PARENT REMINDERS: Please remind your parents of the following key items:

- ⚡️Park only on paved lots and in marked parking spaces. Some will need to park in the stadium parking lot.
- ⚡️The deck is only for swimmers and adults with deck passes.
- ⚡️We are visitors at the OU facility. Please treat the facility and the staff appropriately.
